WARNING
 Under Colorado law a skier assumes the inherent danger of any act to person or property resulting from any of the inherent dangers and risks of skiing and may not recover from any ski area operator for any injury resulting from any of the inherent dangers and risks of skiing including changing weather conditions, existing and changing snow conditions, bare spots, rocks, stumps, trees, cables with metal objects, man-made objects or other objects, existing or changing terrain, and the failure of skiers to ski within their own abilities. Colorado law includes: DRP, Lapses, extreme and hazardous terrain in the inherent dangers and risks of skiing.

Colorado Law prohibits riding the lifts or skiing while under the influence of alcohol or drugs. Colorado Law requires that you give your name and current address to a ski area employee before you leave the vicinity if you are involved in a collision resulting in an injury. Witnesses are encouraged to contact a ski area employee. Do not enter closed trails adjoining a ski area. Winter Park has zero tolerance enforcement of violations. Visitor's pass will be revoked for the season. Do not disembark from a chairlift except at a designated area.

YOUR RESPONSIBILITY CODE
 Always stay in control. Be able to stop or avoid other people or objects. People ahead of you have the right of way. It is your responsibility to avoid them. You must not stop where you obstruct a trail or are not visible from above. When passing, do not cut in or merge into a trail, look uphill and yield to others. Always use devices to help prevent runaway equipment.

Observe all posted signs and warnings. Keep off closed trails and out of closed areas. Prior to using any lift, you must have the knowledge and ability to load, ride and unload safely. This is a general list. It is designed for your own protection and endorsed by the National Ski Area Association, the National Ski Patrol, the Professional Ski Instructors of America, and the American Association of Snowboard Instructors.

Please be safety conscious and ski friendly! Snowcats, snowmobilers, snowmaking and other equipment may be encountered at any time. Stay clear. Activities other than downhill skiing or snowboarding may be prohibited or restricted within the ski area. It is your responsibility to contact trailhead ski area management for details. NO DRINKING. ALLOWED skiing or riding with a child in a front or back seat is strongly discouraged. Insect bites not recommended.
